4. Access shall be provided to residents and guests during t	he duration of the closure - OMC 12.58.015.
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- 5. The street may only be closed for a period of 15 hours (OMC 12.58.015) and no later than 10:00 p.m. It is the applicant's responsibility to clean the streets after the block party is over.
- **6.** No Alcoholic beverages are allowed on public streets OMC 9.16.
- 7. The City of Orange's Police Department will enforce City laws prohibiting excessively loud music OMC 9.39.020.
- 8. The City will not be held responsible for any injuries, accidents or liabilities that might occur during this party.
- 9. Fireworks are illegal in the City of Orange (OMC 8.13.010) and may jeopardize your future ability to obtain a block party permit. Discharge of "Safe & Sane" fireworks is a misdemeanor, and may be prosecuted by the City Attorney. Discharge of illegal fire works is a misdemeanor and will be prosecuted by the District Attorney's Office.
- 10. On the day of the event, post large and easily readable signage ROAD CLOSED AHEAD BLOCK PARTY in advance of the blocked street area.
- 11. Return your application with the appropriate forms at least two weeks prior to the proposed party to the City Clerk's Department 300 E. Chapman Avenue, Orange, CA 92866; or for any questions, please call (714) 744-5500. The City Clerk's Office will mail you a letter indicating if the street closure has been approved.
