FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – May 28, 2015

On the above date, at approximately 0430 hours, officers responded to a 9-1-1 call at the 1900 block of E. Rose Avenue. The call was in reference to a male/adult threatening occupants with a firearm. Upon our arrival, officers were confronted with the suspect who was non-compliant. A handgun was recovered at the scene. The suspect, a male/adult, 23 years of age was shot. The suspect was transported to a nearby hospital and is reported to have non life-threatening injuries. During the incident, a second subject was shot and was also transported to a nearby hospital. He is also reported to have non life-threatening injuries. It is unknown at this time how the second subject sustained his injuries.

The officer involved shooting is being investigated by the Orange County District Attorney's office in cooperation with the Orange Police Department Investigative Bureau. Anyone with information on this incident is asked to contact the Orange Police Department at 714-744-7444.
