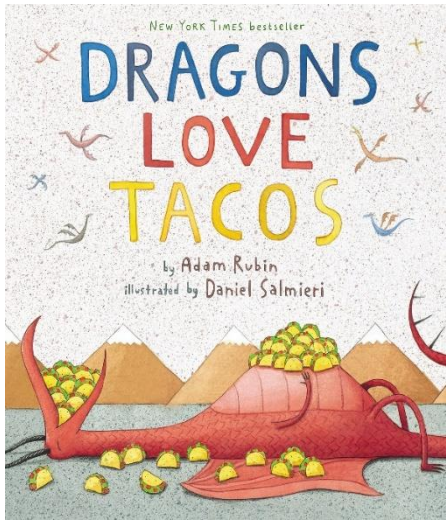


Read & Make: Dragons Love Tacos by Adam Rubin

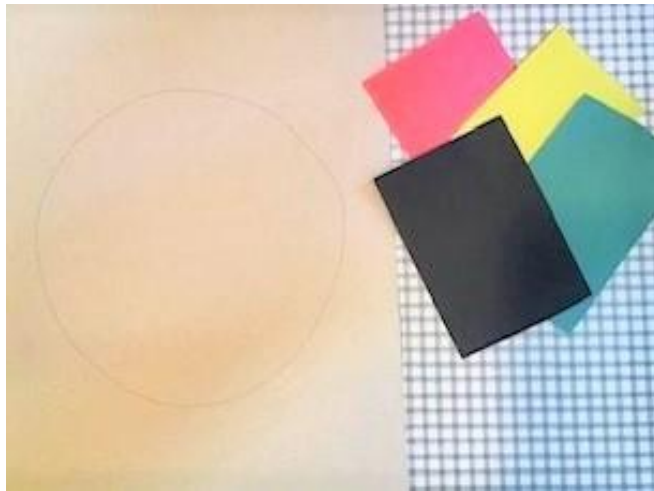


You will need:

- Construction paper in:
 - Tan or brown (1)
 - Yellow or orange (1)
 - Black (1)
 - Green (1)
 - Red (1)
- Scissors
- Pen or pencil

Activity

1. Draw a large circle onto your tan or brown construction paper.



2. Use your remaining colors of construction paper to make your fillings. We decided on an accordion fold for green lettuce strips, thin strips for yellow cheese, triangle for red tomatoes, and crunched up black paper for the meat.

Talk to your child about the colors used. What other things can you or they think of that are those colors? What letters do the colors start with?



3. Cut out your circle and fold in half, you can now begin to fill your newly formed taco with your fillings.
*As you fill up your taco, count the number of items you add to the taco.
Which topping are you using the most? Which one are you using the least?*



If you are feeling extra silly, turn the process into a song:

Filling Up My Taco (to the tune of The More We Get Together)

*I'm filling up my taco, my taco, my taco.
I'm filling up my taco with meat and cheese.
I'm filling up my taco with lettuce and tomatoes.
