



Ingredients

- Graham crackers
- Graham cracker crumbs
- 1-2 tbsp. white frosting
- Blue food coloring
- Fish shaped crackers or candy
- Sprinkles

Supplies

- Several small bowls
- Butter knife and spoon
- Small plastic baggie
- Rolling pin or heavy drinking glass

1. Graham cracker crumbs:

Take one graham cracker and place in a bag. Roll a heavy drinking glass or rolling pin across the bag several times to create small crumbs that resemble sand. Put the crumbs into a bowl and set aside.

2. Blue frosting:

Place your frosting in a bowl and add food coloring one drop at a time until desired color is achieved. Set aside.



3. Take one graham cracker and using a butter knife, spread blue frosting on most of the cracker. Leave the very top of the graham cracker unfrosted.



4. Sprinkle the graham cracker crumbs on the bottom half of your frosted graham cracker to create the look of sand.



5. Add two fish shaped crackers or candies.



6. Use your sprinkles to create air bubbles for the fish or to create other sea life, such as coral, seaweed, a starfish, or a crab.
