

Friends of the Library - Donation Guidelines

The Friends of the Orange Public Library and the Orange Public Library appreciate donations of gently used and new books, DVDs, audio books, and CDs that can be integrated into the Library's collection or sold in the Friends Bookstore to raise funds to support Library activities. All categories of these materials in good condition are welcome. Please do not donate materials that are dirty, shabby, damaged, or contain excessive writing/highlighting.

Please bring your donations to the Friends bookstore at the Main Library or to the customer service counters at the El Modena and Taft Libraries. At the Main location, there is also a donation box available 24/7 at the east end of the building in the parking lot. For large donations (5 or more boxes), please call the Bookstore at (714) 288-2424 to arrange delivery.

Please do not donate magazines, cassettes, or VHS tapes.

Please note: For legal reasons, we do not accept homemade copies of any type of media or commercial software that is not packaged with a book.

Finally, before you donate a book, hold on to the spine and shake each book gently. Very often people leave things in books and forget about them -- important things like receipts with banking numbers, personal photographs, greeting cards with handwritten messages, and even cash. If you forget and we find something and can identify you, we will try to return it to you. Please check before you donate.
